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Use this checklist to organize in-field actions. The signed Compliance Agreement and Exhibit G1 remain the controlling Program documents.

BEFORE TRANS-PLANTING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm G1 field location has been reported to your contracted processor. <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm with your processor that harvested fruit will move only by a transporter operating under a Broomrape Program compliance agreement. <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm harvested fruit will go only to a processing facility operating under a Broomrape Program compliance agreement. <input type="checkbox"/> Designate one equipment entry/exit cleaning area. <input type="checkbox"/> Where feasible, select the latest practical planting date while meeting processor and regional needs. <input type="checkbox"/> Where practical, sequence field operations from lower-risk fields to higher-risk fields. <input type="checkbox"/> Train authorized field personnel, irrigation staff, scouts, equipment operators, and contractors on broomrape ID, equipment sanitation, and footwear cleaning. See this video introducing broomrape. <input type="checkbox"/> Notify the contracted processor at least 48 hours before planting.
TRANS-PLANTING / EARLY SEASON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Use the GDD model to develop a scouting and rogueing plan. Save or print the worksheet for field records. Recheck projected dates within about two weeks of target activities. See this video introducing the broomrape GDD tool and this video explaining broomrape scouting and rogueing. <input type="checkbox"/> Strongly consider Matrix SG chemigation. Follow UC guidance and label directions. UC guidance identifies this as the best available practice to reduce emergence and future seed production. See this video introducing Matrix chemigation. <input type="checkbox"/> Keep the designated cleaning area in use from the start of field work. All equipment and footwear must be cleaned before exiting the field.
GROWING SEASON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Scout and rogue according to the GDD-based plan. Record actual scouting and rogueing dates. See this video introducing the broomrape GDD tool and this video explaining scouting and rogueing. <input type="checkbox"/> Immediately report the exact location of the first suspect broomrape plants of the season to the contracted processor. <input type="checkbox"/> If the detection is outside the Designated Zone, also notify the Broomrape Program immediately. <input type="checkbox"/> Remove, bag, and dispose of suspect broomrape plants according to the GDD-based plan. <input type="checkbox"/> For your own field management, mark where broomrape is found in the field and note relative severity. Use this information to guide rogueing, track whether infestations are spreading and improve future management decisions.
IF FIELD BECOMES IN-FEASIBLE TO HARVEST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Notify the Broomrape Program and contracted processor(s). <input type="checkbox"/> Terminate the crop within 7 days of notification, following Board-recommended guidance.
HARVEST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Notify the contracted processor at least 48 hours before harvesting. <input type="checkbox"/> Use only compliant transporter(s) and compliant processing facility. <input type="checkbox"/> Before equipment leaves the high-risk field, clean it reasonably free of soil and plant debris. <input type="checkbox"/> Require footwear cleaning before field exit.
POST-HARVEST / RECORDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Maintain sanitation expectations for post-harvest work, tillage, bed preparation, and rotational crop operations. <input type="checkbox"/> Monitor the repeated cleaning area in later crops because debris can concentrate risk there. <input type="checkbox"/> Allow Program access to the field with 48 hours advance notice to verify compliance.
