BEFORE FIELD WORK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm G2 field is operating under the correct low-risk exhibit. <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm with your processor that harvested fruit will move only by a transporter operating under a Broomrape Program compliance agreement. <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm harvested fruit will go only to a processing facility operating under a Broomrape Program compliance agreement. <input type="checkbox"/> Train authorized field personnel, irrigation staff, scouts, equipment operators, and contractors on broomrape ID, general sanitation and footwear cleaning guidelines. See this video introducing broomrape.
FIELD ENTRY / SEASON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Before equipment is transported out of a Designated Zone, clean it reasonably free of soil and plant debris. <input type="checkbox"/> Before field personnel, irrigation staff, scouts, equipment operators, and contractors move out of the Designated Zone, their equipment and footwear must be cleaned reasonably free of soil and plant debris. <input type="checkbox"/> Use routine field activity such as irrigation checks, cultivation, hand weeding, vine training, and harvest prep as opportunities to watch for suspect broomrape plants.
HARVEST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Use only compliant transporter(s) and compliant processing facility. <input type="checkbox"/> If the field is inside a Designated Zone, confirm equipment cleaning before movement out of the Designated Zone. <input type="checkbox"/> Keep sanitation expectations in place for harvest equipment, support equipment, any contractor equipment, and footwear of personnel.
IF SUSPECT BROOM-RAPE IS FOUND	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Immediately notify the contracted processor for that field location. <input type="checkbox"/> For your own field management, mark where broomrape is found in the field and note relative severity. Use this information to guide roguing, track whether infestations are spreading and improve future management decisions. <input type="checkbox"/> If the detection is outside the Designated Zone, also notify the Broomrape Program immediately. <input type="checkbox"/> After a broomrape plant detection, Exhibit G2 is voided and the establishment must operate under Exhibit G1.
POST-HARVEST / RECORDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Maintain sanitation expectations for post-harvest work, tillage, bed preparation, and rotational crop operations. <input type="checkbox"/> Questions and required notifications to the Program should be sent to Broomrape_Program@cdfa.ca.gov.
